How to change rear coil springs on **Citroen C3 1** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.4 HDi, CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.1 i, CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.4 i Bivalent, CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.6 16V, CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.4 16V HDi, CITROËN C3 I Hatchback (FC_, FN_) 1.6 16V HDi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – CITROEN C3 1. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 21
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Torque wrench

- Flat chisel
- Hammer
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Replacement: coil springs – Citroen C3 1. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Both coil springs of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right coil springs of the rear suspension.
- Please note: all work on the car Citroen C3 1 should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1 Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. Citroen C3 1
- Remove the wheel.



Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #21.

Remove the fastening bolt. Use a flat metal-working chisel. Use a hammer.



Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: coil springs Citroen C3 1. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Pull down the rear suspension beam. Use a crowbar.



Take out the spring.

Clean the coil spring mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Pull down the rear suspension beam. Use a crowbar.



Install the coil spring together with the rubber mounts into the mounting seats.



Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



16 Install the fastening bolt.

Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 93 Nm torque.



18 Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: coil springs Citroen C3 1. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Treat the shock absorber fasteners. Use copper grease.

Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.



21 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
 Citroen C3 1
- Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 nm torque.

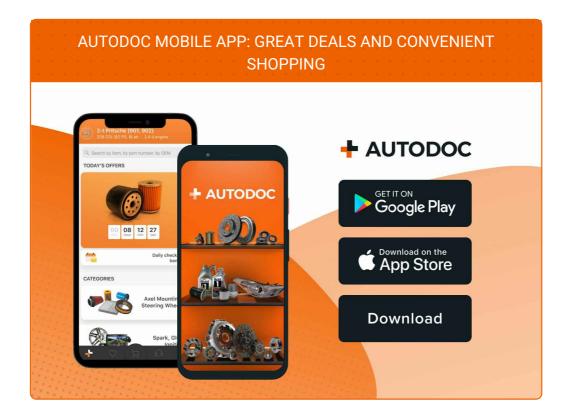
