
How to change glow plugs on **VW Caddy 3 van** – replacement guide

# important!

# REPLACEMENT: GLOW PLUGS - VW CADDY 3 VAN. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- WD-40 spray
- Electronic spray
- High-temperature ceramic grease
- Torque wrench
- Spark plug socket # 10
- Fender cover

### Replacement: glow plugs – VW Caddy 3 van. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- The replacement procedure is identical for all glow plugs.
- Wear gloves to protect your hands from hot surfaces.
- Please note: all work on the car VW Caddy 3 van should be done with the engine switched off.

### CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Open the bonnet.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Before getting down to work, start the engine and let it warm up to operating temperature.



- Shut off the engine.
- 5 Detach the glow plug wiring connectors.



6 Treat the glow plugs. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the glow plugs. Use the spark plug socket #10. Use a torque wrench.

Remove the glow plugs.



Treat the glow plugs. Use high-temperature ceramic grease.



#### Please note!

- Do not touch the heating element as fingerprints may cause malfunction.
- 10 Install new glow plugs to their mounting seats.



Tighten the glow plugs. Use the spark plug socket #10. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 15 nm torque.

### Replacement: glow plugs – VW Caddy 3 van. AUTODOC recommends:

- Don't tighten the plugs with excessive force. Exceeding tightening torque can damage the thread connection.
- Be careful when working with a spark plug wrench. Its skewing can cause damage to the threaded connection.





Attach the glow plug wiring connectors.



Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.



Shut off the engine.
