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How to change engine oil and filter on **BMW E90**diesel – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

BMW 3 Compact (E46) 320td 2.0, BMW 3 Saloon (E46) 320d 2.0, BMW 3 Touring (E46) 320d 2.0, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 320Cd 2.0, BMW 3 Compact (E46) 318td 2.0, BMW X3 (E83) 2.0 d, BMW 3 Convertible (E46) 320Cd 2.0, BMW 3 Saloon (E90) 320d 2.0, BMW 3 Saloon (E46) 318d 2.0, BMW 3 Touring (E46) 318d 2.0, BMW 3 Touring (E91) 320d 2.0, BMW 3 Saloon (E90) 318d 2.0, BMW 7 (E65, E66, E67) 745d 4.4, BMW 5 Saloon (E60) 520d 2.0, BMW 5 Touring (E61) 520d 2.0, (+3)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – BMW E90. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Drive socket # 8
- Drive socket # 17
- Drive socket # 36
- Flat screwdriver

- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Microfibre towel
- Fender cover

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Use only new O-rings during installation.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work BMW E90

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Open the hood.



2

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



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3 Unscrew the oil filler plug.



Unscrew the filter housing cap together with the old filter element. Use a drive socket #36. Use a ratchet wrench.



Put the old filter cartridge in the container.



6 Cover the oil filter housing with a microfibre towel to prevent dirt and foreign objects from getting into the system.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



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Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. AUTODOC recommends:

• The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.





Remove the oil pan cover. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



Put a waste oil container with at least 6 l capacity under the drainage hole.



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Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



Drain the used oil.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Caution! The oil may be hot.
- Detach the oil filter from the filter cover.



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Remove the oil filter cover O-ring. Use a flat screwdriver.



Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Install a new O-ring to its mounting seat on the filter cover.



Install the new oil filter to the mounting seat on the filter cover.

Please note!

• Make sure to install the filter correctly. Don't mix up the sides of the part.


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




19 Remove the O-ring from the plug.



Clean the plug and put a new 0-ring on it.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.
- Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.
- Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole.




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Reinstall the oil pan lower cover.



Tighten the fasteners of the oil pan lower cover. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Lower the car.
- Remove the microfibre towel from the oil filter housing.



Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



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28 Screw the new filter into its place.



Screw the cap. Use a drive socket #36. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



Remove the oil filler cap. Insert the funnel.

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Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 5.5 l.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

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Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Tighten the oil filler cap.



Run the engine for a few minutes. After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.



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Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.

Remove the fender protection cover.



Close the hood.



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Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW E90. Tip:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




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
