
How to change rear strut mount on **VW Polo 9N** – replacement guide

## important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.9 TDI, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.6, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.9 SDI, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.4 16V, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.8, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.8 T, VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 2.3 V5, VW New Beetle Hatchback (9C1, 1C1) 2.0, VW New Beetle Hatchback (9C1, 1C1) 1.9 TDI, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 1.6, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 2.0, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 2.3 V5, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 1.9 TDI, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 1.8, VW Bora Saloon (1J2) 1.4 16V, (+102)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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## REPLACEMENT: STRUT MOUNT – VW POLO 9N. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #16
- Drive socket # 16

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

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## Replacement: strut mount – VW Polo 9N. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the mounts of the right and left shock absorbers of the rear suspension.
- Both mounts of the rear shock struts should be replaced simultaneously.
- Be sure to replace all self-locking nuts and bolts during installation.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## REPLACEMENT: STRUT MOUNT – VW POLO 9N. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



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Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.



Unscrew the wheel bolts.



### **AUTODOC** recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Polo 9N

Remove the wheel.

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Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



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Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Remove the fastening bolt.
- Detach the lower part of the shock absorber. Use a crowbar.



Unscrew the upper fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



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### **AUTODOC** recommends:

 Important! Hold the shock absorber while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Polo 9N

Remove the shock absorber.



- Clean the shock absorber rod fastener. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Remove the shock absorber piston rod fastening. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the top strut mount.



## Replacement: strut mount – VW Polo 9N. AUTODOC recommends:

 Examine the shock absorber dust cap and the bump stop. Replace them if necessary.

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16 Install a new strut mount.



Screw the shock strut piston rod upper fastening. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 nm torque.



- Treat the shock absorber mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Place the shock absorber in the wheel arch and secure it.



### **AUTODOC** recommends:

 Important! Hold the shock absorber while screwing in the fastening bolts. VW Polo 9N

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Tighten the top shock absorber fastening. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.+90°



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.
- Attach the lower part of the shock absorber.
- 22 Install the fastening bolt.
- Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.+90°



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

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Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



## AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: strut mount VW Polo 9N. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Treat the shock absorber fasteners. Use copper grease.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.









28 Install the wheel.



## **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. VW Polo 9N
- Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 nm torque.



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Remove the jacks and chocks.







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
