

How to change rear shock absorbers on **VW Golf 6** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 1.9 TDI, VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 1.6 FSI, VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 2.0 TDI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 16V, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 FSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.9 TDI, VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 1.6, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.6 FSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 FSI, VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 2.0 FSI, VW Touran I (1T1, 1T2) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.6, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 16V, (+ 39)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.





# REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – VW GOLF 6. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 14
- Drive socket #15
- Drive socket # 18
- Drive socket # 21
- Combination spanner #14
- Combination spanner #18

- Combination spanner #21
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Tap wrench
- Vice
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

#### Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf 6. Professionals recommend:

- Both shock absorbers of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right shock absorbers of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# **REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – VW GOLF 6. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:**



Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



3

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.







Unscrew the wheel bolts.



## AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Golf 6



Remove the wheel.

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



7

Unscrew the fastener connecting the control arm to the rear knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.







Lower the hydraulic transmission jack by 10-15 cm.



# Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf 6. AUTODOC recommends:

• Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.



Remove the spring.

Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #21. Use a tap wrench.







Unscrew the upper fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #15. Use a ratchet wrench.



# Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf 6. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• To avoid injuries, hold the shock absorber when undoing the fastening bolts.



Remove the shock absorber.



13

Clean the shock absorber rod fastener. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.







Grip the shock absorber in a vice.



15

Remove the shock absorber piston rod fastening. Use a combination spanner #14.



16

Remove the shock absorber mount, boot and bump stop.



### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: shock absorbers VW Golf 6. Carefully inspect the mount, the boot, and the bump stop of the shock absorber. Replace if necessary.
- Before installing a new shock absorber you should pump it manually 3-5 times.





Install the mount, boot and bump stop onto a new shock absorber.



#### 18

Fix the shock absorber mount. Use a combination spanner #14. Use a drive socket #14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



19

Release the vice and take out the shock absorber.



20

Place the shock absorber in the wheel arch and secure it.



# AUTODOC recommends:

 Important! Hold the shock absorber while screwing in the fastening bolts. VW Golf 6





21

Tighten the shock absorber mount fasteners. Use a drive socket #15. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 50 Nm torque.+45°



# AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use WD-40 spray.



23

Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 180 Nm torque.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.







Install the spring.



25

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



26

Tighten the fasteners connecting the control arm to the rear knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.+90°



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Remove the support from under the rear arm.







### AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf 6. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

28

Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.



29

Install the wheel.



## Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf 6. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.



Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.







Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.

Remove the jacks and chocks.






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
