



How to change
serpentine belt on
Mercedes W168 –
replacement guide

** Important!**

This replacement procedure can be used for:

MERCEDES-BENZ A-Class (W168) A 160 CDI (168.006), MERCEDES-BENZ A-Class (W168) A 170 CDI (168.009, 168.109), MERCEDES-BENZ Vaneo (414) 1.7 CDI (414.700)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – MERCEDES
W168. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Combination spanner #15

BUY TOOLS

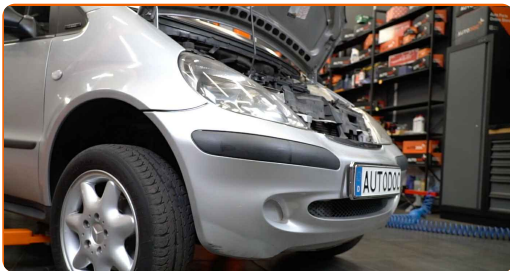
Replacement: serpentine belt – Mercedes W168. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – MERCEDES W168. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1 Open the bonnet.

2 Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



3 Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #15.



4 Remove the V-ribbed belt.

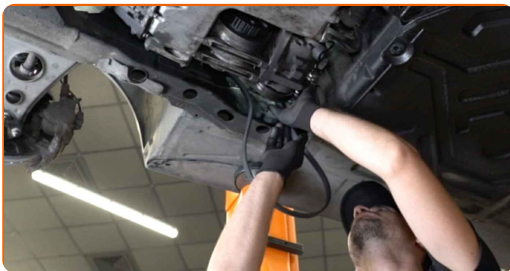


Replacement: serpentine belt – Mercedes W168. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

5 Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.

6 Install the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – Mercedes W168. Tip:

- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.

7 Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #15.

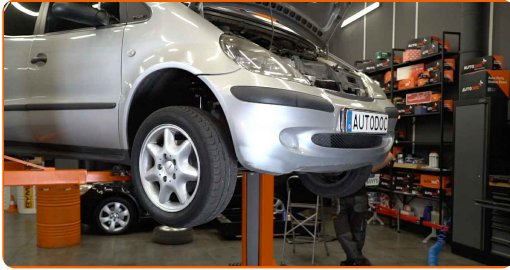
8 Place the serpentine belt on the crankshaft pulley.

9 Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position. Use a combination spanner #15.
