
The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – OPEL ASTRA H SALOON. TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Combination spanner #19
- Torx bit T25
- Ratchet wrench

- Clip removal tool
- Fender cover

Replacement: serpentine belt – Opel Astra H saloon. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – OPEL ASTRA H SALOON. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

Open the hood.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

Remove the wheel arch cover.



Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #19.



Remove the V-ribbed belt.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.



Replacement: serpentine belt – Opel Astra H saloon. Professionals recommend:

- Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #19.



10 Install the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – Opel Astra H saloon. AUTODOC recommends:

• Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position. Use a combination spanner #19.



12 Install the wheel arch cover to its mounting seat.



Install and tighten the wheel arch cover fasteners. Use Torx T25. Use a ratchet wrench.



Lower the car.

Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly. 15



- Shut off the engine. 16
- Remove the fender protection cover. 17



Close the hood. 18
