
(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI A1 Citycarver (GBH) 25 TFSI, AUDI A1 Citycarver (GBH) 30 TFSI, AUDI A1 Citycarver (GBH) 35 TFSI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW GOLF VI (5K1) 2.0 GTi







AUTODOC recommends:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: WINDSHIELD WIPERS – AUDI A1 CITYCARVER (GBH). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:



Switch on the ignition. Pull the windscreen wiper stalk to the downward position.

Switch off the ignition. In the service mode, the wipers will be in the upper position.

Prepare the new windscreen wipers.





Pull the wiper arm away from the glass surface until it stops.

Press the clip. Use a flat screwdriver. Remove the blade from the wiper arm.





Replacement: windshield wipers – AUDI A1 Citycarver (GBH). AUTODOC recommends:

• When replacing the wiper blade, take caution to prevent the spring-loaded wiper arm from hitting the glass.



Install the new wiper blade and carefully press the wiper arm down to the glass.

By doing so, you will switch the windscreen wipers from the service mode to the operation mode.


