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How to change engine oil and filter on AUDI A4
B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE) – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE) 2.0 TDI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: AUDI A4 B6 Avant (8E5) 1.9 TDI

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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – AUDI A4 B6/B7 CONVERTIBLE (8H7, 8HE). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Oil filter cup socket 76-14F
- Drive socket # 10
- Drive socket # 19
- Ratchet wrench

- Torque wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Flat Screwdriver
- Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE).
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – AUDI A4 B6/B7 CONVERTIBLE (8H7, 8HE). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the engine cover caps. Use a flat screwdriver.



Unscrew the engine cover fastener. Use a drive socket #10.



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5 Remove the engine cover.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Raise the engine cover, holding it on two sides simultaneously.
- Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Prepare a container for the old oil filter.



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Unscrew the filter housing cap together with the old filter element. Use the 76-14F socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



Put the old oil filter in the container.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE).

Professionals recommend:

- Move up the container. The oil starts to drain out of the drainage hole immediately after you have removed the oil filter.
- Cover the oil filter housing with a microfibre towel to prevent dirt and foreign objects from getting into the system.

10 Unscrew the oil filler plug.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE). Tip:

- The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.
- Undo the fasteners of the oil pan lower cover. Use a drive socket #10.



13 Remove the oil pan cover.

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Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Put a waste oil container with at least 4 l capacity under the drainage hole.



Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #19. Use a ratchet wrench.



Drain the used oil.

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Caution! The oil may be hot.

Detach the oil filter from the filter cover.



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Remove old o-rings from the oil filter cover. Use a flat screwdriver.



- Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.
- Install new O-rings (2 pieces) and a new oil filter to their mounting seats on the filter cover.



Please note!

- Make sure to install the filter correctly. Don't mix up the sides of the part.
- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole.



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Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Reinstall the oil pan lower cover.



Tighten the fasteners of the oil pan lower cover. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Lower the car.

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Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.

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Screw the new filter into its place.



Install a new oil filter housing cover and tighten it. Use the 76-14F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



Install the engine cover and secure it.

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AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure the engine cover is properly seated. It should not be displaced with respect to the guiding fasteners.
- Caution! Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the fasteners of the car. AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE)

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Screw in the engine cover fasteners. Use a drive socket #10.



- 33 Install the engine cover caps.
- Remove the oil filler cap. Insert the funnel.



Pour new oil into the engine in the amount recommended by the car manufacturer.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE).

Professionals recommend:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

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Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- 37 Install the oil filler cap.
- Tighten the oil filler cap.



- Run the engine for a few minutes. After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.
- Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



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Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness.
 If necessary, carefully tighten them up.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – AUDI A4 B6/B7 Convertible (8H7, 8HE). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.



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
