REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – AUDI A6 AVANT (4F5, C6). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torx bit T25
- Drive socket # 10

- Flat Screwdriver
- Clic-R collar pliers
- Fender cover

Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – AUDI A6 AVANT (4F5, C6). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the engine cover.



Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Raise the engine cover, holding it on two sides simultaneously.

4 Unscrew the fasteners of the coolant reservoir. Use Torx T25.



Remove the coolant reservoir.



6 Clean the fuel filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- Loosen the fastening clamp of the fuel filter pipe. Use clic-R collar pliers.
- Disconnect the pipe from the fuel filter.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.

2 Loosen the fuel filter mounting. Use a drive socket #10.



Disconnect the pipe from the fuel filter.



Remove the fuel filter. Put the old filter cartridge in the container.



Remove the o-rings. Use a flat screwdriver.



Install new o-rings. Use a flat screwdriver.

14 Install a new fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6). Professionals recommend:

- Make sure that the fuel filter is positioned correctly. Consider the fuel flow direction mark.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6) It's important to only use high-quality car parts.

Tighten the fuel filter fasteners. Use a drive socket #10.



Tighten the fastening clamp of the fuel filter pipe. Use clic-R collar pliers.



19 Install the coolant reservoir.



Screw in the coolant reservoir fasteners. Use Torx T25.



- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- 22 Shut off the engine.

23 Install the engine cover and secure it.



Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Make sure the engine cover is properly seated. It should not be displaced with respect to the guiding fasteners.
- Do not apply excessive force when installing the part. Otherwise you may damage the fasteners.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.

Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6). AUTODOC recommends:

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




