## REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Combination spanner #17
- Phillips screwdriver

- Flat screwdriver
- Fender cover

### Replacement: serpentine belt – AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). AUTODOC recommends:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Unscrew the fasteners of the air distribution housing assembly. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Remove the air distribution housing assembly.



Unscrew the engine cover fastener. Use a flat screwdriver.

6 Remove the engine cover.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: serpentine belt AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #17.



Remove the V-ribbed belt.

#### Replacement: serpentine belt – AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). Tip from AUTODOC:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

- Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.
- 10 Install the V-ribbed belt.



Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #17.



Place the serpentine belt on the crankshaft pulley.



#### Replacement: serpentine belt – AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). Tip:

- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.
- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt is properly tensioned.
- Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position. Use a combination spanner #17.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

- Shut off the engine.
- Reinstall the air distribution housing assembly.



Screw in the fasteners of the air distribution housing assembly. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



18 Install the engine cover and secure it.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Make sure the engine cover is properly seated. It should not be displaced with respect to the guiding fasteners.
- Replacement: serpentine belt AUDI A8 D3 (4E2, 4E8). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.

Screw in the engine cover fasteners. Use a flat screwdriver.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.



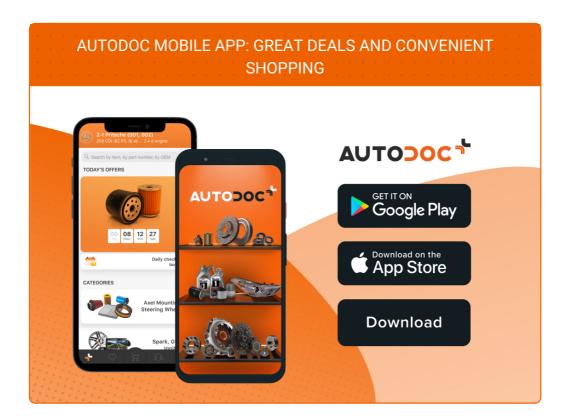
