
How to change air filter on AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5) 2.7 T quattro, AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5) 4.2 V8 quattro

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – AUDI ALLROAD (4BH, C5). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Electronic spray
- Phillips screwdriver

- Microfibre towel
- Fender cover

Replacement: air filter – AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Please note: all work on the car AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the air filter housing cover.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: air filter – AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.

4 Unscrew the fasteners of the air distribution housing assembly. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Remove the air distribution housing assembly.



6 Detach the mass air flow sensor connector.



7 Release the air filter cover clips.

Slightly raise the cover of the air filter housing.

9 Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



Clean the air filter cover and housing.



Replacement: air filter – AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Before cleaning the air filter cover and housing, cover the air duct parts, mass airflow sensor (if available), throttle valve with a clean cloth.

Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.



Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



Replacement: air filter – AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). AUTODOC recommends:

- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Attention! Use quality filters AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5).
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.

AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: air filter – AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.





Treat the mass air flow sensor connector. Use dielectric grease.



17 Attach the mass air flow sensor connector.

Reinstall the air distribution housing assembly.

Screw in the fasteners of the air distribution housing assembly. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



20 Install the air filter housing cover.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: air filter AUDI Allroad (4BH, C5). To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
