

How to change fuel filter on AUDI Allroad C5
(4BH) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH) 2.7 T quattro, AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH) 4.2 V8 quattro

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: AUDI 80 B4 Saloon (8C2) 2.0

REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – AUDI ALLROAD C5 (4BH). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #17
- Combination spanner #19

- Combination spanner #22
- Drive socket # 10
- Ratchet wrench
- Fluid container

Replacement: fuel filter – AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – AUDI ALLROAD C5 (4BH). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- Unscrew the fastener attaching the fuel supply line to the fuel filter housing. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a combination spanner #22.



- Prepare a container for fluids.
- Disconnect the pipe from the fuel filter.

Replacement: fuel filter - AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH). Tip:

- Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.
- Unscrew the fastener attaching the fuel supply line to the fuel filter housing. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a combination spanner #22.



6 Disconnect the pipe from the fuel filter.



- Clean the fuel filter bracket. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the fuel filter bracket fixing bolts. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.

- Remove the fuel filter together with its bracket.
- 10 Remove the fuel filter.



11 Install a new fuel filter.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure that the fuel filter is positioned correctly. Consider the fuel flow direction mark.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH) It's important to only use high-quality filters.

Install the new fuel filter together with its bracket.

Screw the fixing bolts of the fuel filter bracket. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Attach the pipe to the fuel filter.

Screw the fastener attaching the fuel supply line to the fuel filter housing. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a combination spanner #22.



- Take the fluid container away from under the fuel filter.
- Lower the car.

Replacement: fuel filter - AUDI Allroad C5 (4BH). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Before starting off, switch the ignition on and off several times. This should be done to activate the fuel pump to make it pump fuel through the fuel system.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.

AUTODOC recommends:

 To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




