This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 2.0 E, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 2.3 E, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 2.6, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 2.8, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 2.0 16V, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 1.9 TDI, AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) 1.8

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – AUDI CABRIOLET (8G7, B4). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- High-temperature ceramic grease
- Torque wrench

- Combination spanner #16
- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 17
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Wheel chock

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
Replacement: anti roll bar links – AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4). AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the stabiliser links on AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) in pairs.
- The replacement procedure is identical for both stabiliser links on the same axle.
- Please note: all work on the car AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



3

Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.





Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4)

Remove the wheel.



6

Clean all joints of the stabiliser link. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.





7

Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



8

Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a combination spanner #17.



9

Remove the stabilizer rod.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Examine the stabiliser bushes. Replace them if necessary.



10

Clean the mounting seats of the stabiliser link. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



11

Install a new stabiliser link and tighten the fasteners.



12

Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



13

Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



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14

Treat all joints of the stabiliser link. Use copper grease.



15

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use high-temperature ceramic grease.



16

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: anti roll bar links – AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

17

Install the wheel.





AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. AUDI Cabriolet (8G7, B4)
- 18

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



19

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.



20

Remove the jacks and chocks.
