This replacement procedure can be used for: AUDI TT Coupe (8N3) 1.8 T, AUDI TT Coupe (8N<u>3</u>) 1.8 T quattro

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

Replacement: serpentine belt - AUDI TT Coupe (8N3). Tip from AUTODOC:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Open the bonnet.

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #16.

Remove the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – AUDI TT Coupe (8N3). AUTODOC recommends:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.

Install the V-ribbed belt.



8

Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #16.

Place the V-ribbed belt on the tensioner pulley.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.





11

Rotate the crankshaft several times to check whether the new V-ribbed belt is working correctly. Use a drive socket #19. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt is properly tensioned.




Run the engine for a few minutes.
