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How to change engine oil and filter on **Mercedes W245** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – MERCEDES W245. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 27
- Ratchet wrench

- Torque wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Flat Screwdriver
- Fender cover

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Please note: all work on the car Mercedes W245 should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Open the hood.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Unscrew the oil filler plug.



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Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.
- Put a waste oil container with at least 6 l capacity under the drainage hole.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.



Brain the used oil.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.
- Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Unscrew the filter housing cap together with the old filter element. Use a drive socket #27. Use a ratchet wrench.



Prepare a container for the old oil filter. Put the old filter cartridge in the container.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. Professionals recommend:

- Move up the container. The oil starts to drain out of the drainage hole immediately after you have removed the oil filter.
- Detach the oil filter from the filter cover.



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Remove the oil filter cover O-ring. Use a flat screwdriver.



Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Install a new 0-ring to its mounting seat on the filter cover.



Install the new oil filter to the mounting seat on the filter cover.



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Please note!

• Make sure to install the filter correctly. Don't mix up the sides of the part.

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Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



Screw the cap. Use a drive socket #27. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole.



Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 28 Nm torque.



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Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Lower the car.



Remove the oil filler cap.



24 Insert the funnel.

Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 5 l.



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






Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. AUTODOC recommends:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.





Please note!

• The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

27 Install the oil filler cap.



Tighten the oil filler cap.

Run the engine for a few minutes. After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.



Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.

Remove the fender protection cover.



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Close the hood.

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Mercedes W245. Tip:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




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
