AUDI A4 Saloon (8D2, B5) 1.6, AUDI A4 Avant (8D5, B5) 1.6, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 1.8 T, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 2.0, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 1.8 T quattro, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 3.0, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 3.0 quattro, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 1.9 TDI, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 2.5 TDI quattro, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 1.6, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 2.5 TDI, AUDI A4 Avant (8E5, B6) 1.6, AUDI A4 Avant (8E5, B6) 2.0, AUDI A4 Avant (8E5, B6) 3.0, (+62)










REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – AUDI A4 B6. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Phillips screwdriver
- Flat Screwdriver

- Torx bit T20
- Fender cover

Replacement: air filter – Audi A4 B6. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – AUDI A4 B6. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1

Open the hood.



- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Loosen the air intake fastening. Use Torx T20.



Detach the air duct housing from the air filter housing.

Disconnect the air intake pipe fastening. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



6 Remove the air intake pipe.



Detach the vacuum pipe. Use a flat screwdriver.



Undo the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Slightly raise the cover of the air filter housing.

Remove the filter element from the filter housing. Clean the air filter cover and housing.



Replacement: air filter – Audi A4 B6. Tip:

• Before cleaning the air filter cover and housing, cover the air duct parts, mass airflow sensor (if available), throttle valve with a clean cloth.

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



Replacement: air filter – Audi A4 B6. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Audi A4 B6 It's important to only use high-quality filters.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.



Screw in the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



14 Attach the vacuum pipe.



Install the air intake pipe and secure it. Use a flat screwdriver.



16 Install the air duct housing.

Secure the fastener of the air intake duct. Use Torx T20.



- 18 Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.






