

How to change front lower arm on **Citroën Berlingo M** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:


The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: FRONT LOWER ARM – CITROËN BERLINGO M. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Ceramic grease
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #16
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 16
- Drive socket # 18

- Drive socket # 36
- Wheel impact socket #19
- Ratchet wrench
- Flat chisel
- Hammer
- Tap wrench
- Pin punch
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

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


AUTODOC recommends:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right lower control arms.
- Please note: all work on the car Citroën Berlingo M should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1 Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Raise the car.



AUTODOC recommends:

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.

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Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: front lower arm – Citroën Berlingo M. Tip from AUTODOC:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

Remove the wheel.



6 Clean the fastener of the driveshaft. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Remove the cotter pin. Use a crowbar.



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








Remove the circlip.



Unscrew the fastener connecting the drive shaft to the wheel hub. Use a drive socket #36. Use a tap wrench.



10 Remove the fastening nut.

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Loosen the CV axle in the wheel hub. Use a pin punch. Use a hammer.



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Clean the fastener connecting the ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Prop up the steering knuckle. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Unscrew the fastener connecting the ball joint to the suspension control arm. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the fastening bolt.



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Remove the support from under the steering knuckle.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: front lower arm Citroën Berlingo M. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Release the fastener that connects the control arm ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a crowbar. Use a hammer.



Disconnect the ball joint from the steering knuckle. Use a crowbar.



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Detach the driveshaft from the steering knuckle.



Replacement: front lower arm – Citroën Berlingo M. Professionals recommend:

• Make sure that the drive shaft is not unloaded (when the car is jacked).

Clean the fastener that connects the suspension arm to the subframe. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the front arm fastener. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



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Clean the fasteners connecting the control arm to the subframe. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the rear fasteners of the suspension arm. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the fastening bolts.



Remove the arm. Use a crowbar.



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Clean the suspension arm mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



27 Install a new arm.



Replacement: front lower arm – Citroën Berlingo M. AUTODOC recommends:

- During the installation process, use only new bolts and nuts.
- Do not damage the ball joint cover.

28 Install the fastening bolts.



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Screw in the fastening bolts. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #13. Use a drive socket #16. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



Clean the splines of the drive shaft CV joint. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Install the steering knuckle on the CV axle.



Treat the ball joint fastener. Use copper grease.



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Release the fastener that connects the control arm ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a flat metal-working chisel. Use a hammer.



Connect the ball joint to the steering knuckle.



35 Install the fastening bolt.



Tighten the fastener connecting the ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



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Tighten the rear fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



Tighten the rear fastener of the control arm. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.



Prop up the steering knuckle. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Replacement: front lower arm – Citroën Berlingo M. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• For tightening the fasteners correctly, you have to jack up the suspension components to their working position.

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Tighten the front fastener connecting the control arm to the subframe. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque 40 wrench. Tighten it to 95 Nm torque.



Remove the support from under the steering knuckle. 41



AUTODOC recommends:

- Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.
- Install the fastening nut. 42



Screw the nut of the drive shaft. 43

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Tighten the drive shaft nut. Use a drive socket #36. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 320 Nm torque. 44



Restake the fastener of the driveshaft. Use a flat metal-working chisel. Use a hammer. 45



Treat all joints of the arm. Use copper grease. 46



Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. 47



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Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use ceramic grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: front lower arm – Citroën Berlingo M. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. Citroën Berlingo M

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.





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
