

How to change engine oil and filter on **BMW 3 Coupe (E46)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle


(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 323Ci 2.5, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 328Ci 2.8, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 320Ci 2.0, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 320Ci 2.2, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 325Ci 2.5, BMW 3 Coupe (E46) 330Ci 3.0

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: BMW 5 Saloon (E39) 530i 3.0

Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW 3 Coupe (E46). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Please note: all work on the car BMW 3 Coupe (E46) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Unscrew the oil filler plug.

Open the hood.





Pull up the oil dipstick.







Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Unscrew the filter housing cap together with the old filter element. Use a drive socket #36. Use a ratchet wrench.

Put the old oil filter in the container.

Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

Put a waste oil container with at least 7 l capacity under the drainage hole.







Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #19. Use a ratchet wrench.

Drain the used oil.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW 3 Coupe (E46). Tip:

• Caution! The oil may be hot.



Remove the oil filter cover O-ring. Use a flat screwdriver.







Clean the oil filter housing cap. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Install a new O-ring to its mounting seat on the filter cover.

Install the new oil filter to the mounting seat on the filter cover.

Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.







Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.

Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Lower the car.

Clean the oil filter seat.





Install the cover of the oil filter housing and screw it on. Use a drive socket #36. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.









Remove the oil filler cap.

Insert the funnel.

Pour new oil into the engine in the amount recommended by the car manufacturer.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – BMW 3 Coupe (E46). Professionals recommend:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.




Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.
















• Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.


