
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How to change front brake pads on **BMW Z4 Coupe (E86)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: BMW Z4 Coupe (E86) 3.0 si

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: BMW 3 Touring (E46) 330d 3.0



REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – BMW Z4 COUPE (E86). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Anti-squeal paste
- HEX bit No.H7.
- Wheel impact socket #17

- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock



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Replacement: brake pads - BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work BMW Z4 Coupe (E86).

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.





Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.



Remove the wheel.





Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.

Detach the brake caliper retaining spring. Use a crowbar.

Remove the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins. Use a crowbar.

Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use HEX No.H7. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the brake caliper.





Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). AUTODOC recommends:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.



Remove the brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip:

• Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.



Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.





Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Professionals recommend:

- After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Treat the brake caliper bracket where it contacts the brake pads. Use anti-squeal paste.





Replacement: brake pads - BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.



Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip:

• Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.



Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use HEX No.H7. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



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Install the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins.

Install the brake caliper retaining spring.

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



23

Install the wheel.





Replacement: brake pads - BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



25

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 nm torque.

Remove the jacks and chocks.



Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). AUTODOC recommends:

• Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and refill if necessary.





Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

• BMW Z4 Coupe (E86) – Press the brake pedal several times with the engine shut down until you feel the resistance built up.

Close the hood.

Replacement: brake pads – BMW Z4 Coupe (E86). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.



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
