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How to change rear brake pads on **Fiat Bravo 2** – replacement guide



This replacement procedure can be used for: FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.4 16V, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.6 D Multijet, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.4 LPG, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.9 D Multijet, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.4, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 1.4 T-Jet, FIAT BRAVO II (198) 2.0 D Multijet

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – FIAT BRAVO 2. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 13

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: brake pads – Fiat Bravo 2. AUTODOC recommends:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – FIAT BRAVO 2. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:



Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.

Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



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Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: brake pads - Fiat Bravo 2. Tip:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.



Remove the wheel.





Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the brake caliper. Use a crowbar.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.



Remove the brake pads.



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Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.





Replacement: brake pads - Fiat Bravo 2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.



Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



Replacement: brake pads - Fiat Bravo 2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.



Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads - Fiat Bravo 2. AUTODOC recommends:

• Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a wire brush.

18

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



19

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: brake pads – Fiat Bravo 2. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install the wheel.



Replacement: brake pads - Fiat Bravo 2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

21

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



22

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Important! Replacement: brake pads – Fiat Bravo 2. Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.





Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap. Close the hood.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Fiat Bravo 2 – Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until it feels firm.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



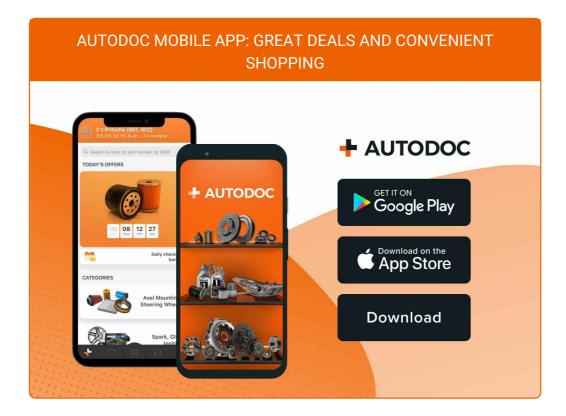
Replacement: brake pads – Fiat Bravo 2. Professionals recommend:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.





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
