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How to change rear brake pads on **Audi A6 4F2** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

AUDI A3 Hatchback (8P1) 1.6 E-Power, AUDI A3 Sportback (8PA) 1.6 E-Power, AUDI TT Coupe (8J3) 2.0 TFSI, AUDI TT Coupe (8J3) 2.0 TFSI quattro, AUDI TT Roadster (8J9) 2.0 TFSI, AUDI TT Roadster (8J9) 2.0 TFSI quattro, AUDI A3 Sportback (8PA) RS3 quattro, AUDI A3 Convertible (8P7) 1.4 TFSI, AUDI TT Coupe (8J3) 2.5 RS quattro, AUDI A6 Saloon (4F2, C6) 3.0 TFSI quattro, AUDI A6 Avant (4F5, C6) 3.0 TFSI quattro, AUDI TT Roadster (8J9) 2.5 RS quattro, AUDI A4 Saloon (8E2, B6) 3.0 quattro, AUDI A6 Avant (4B5, C5) 1.9 TDI, AUDI A3 Hatchback (8P1) 2.0 FSI, (+ 117)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – AUDI A6 4F2. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #15
- Drive socket # 13

- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

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Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. Tip from AUTODOC:


- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This
 provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – AUDI A6 4F2. TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



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A Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.



5 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. Tip:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.
- 6 Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a combination spanner #15. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the brake caliper. Use a crowbar.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. AUTODOC recommends:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

Remove the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



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Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

 Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. Tip:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

14 Install new brake pads.



AUTODOC recommends:

Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

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Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use a combination spanner #15. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake pads - Audi A6 4F2. AUTODOC recommends:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

18 Install the wheel.



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AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. Audi A6 4F2





Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and refill if necessary.

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Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Audi A6 4F2 – Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until it feels firm.

Close the hood.



Replacement: brake pads – Audi A6 4F2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement.
 Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.




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
