This replacement procedure can be used for: CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_) 1.6 HDI 75, CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_) 1.6 HDI 90

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE MOUNTS – CITROËN BERLINGO / BERLINGO FIRST VAN (M_). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Sealant
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # E14

- Torx bit T50
- Ratchet wrench
- Clip removal tool
- Jack
- Fender cover
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: engine mounts – CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_).

AUTODOC experts recommend:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE MOUNTS – CITROËN BERLINGO / BERLINGO FIRST VAN (M_). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Release the coolant reservoir retainers. Use a clip removal tool.



Remove the coolant reservoir cap.



Remove the engine cover.



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






AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: engine mounts – CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.





Clean the engine mount fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the fasteners that connect the engine mount to the car body. Use a drive socket #E14. Use a ratchet wrench.



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9 Unscrew the engine mount fasteners. Use Torx T50. Use a ratchet wrench.



10 Remove the engine mount.



Replacement: engine mounts – CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_).

AUTODOC recommends:

• Carefully check the other engine mounts and replace them if necessary.

Remove the fastening bolts.



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Clean the mounting seat of the engine mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Treat the engine mount fasteners. Use a sealant.



Install the engine mount to its mounting seat.



15 Install the fastening bolts.



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Screw in the engine mount fasteners. Use Torx T50. Use a ratchet wrench.



Screw in the fasteners that connect the engine mount to the car body. Use a drive socket #E14. Use a ratchet wrench.



Tighten the fasteners that connect the engine mount to the car body. Use a drive socket #E14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 60 nm torque.



Tighten the engine mount fastening bolts. Use Torx T50. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 60 nm torque.



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Remove the support from under the engine.



Treat the engine mount fasteners. Use copper grease.



Install the engine cover and secure it.



Replacement: engine mounts – CITROËN Berlingo / Berlingo First Van (M_).

Professionals recommend:

• When installing, do not use excessive force to avoid damage to the part.

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Install the coolant reservoir cap.



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Attach the coolant reservoir using its retainers.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.



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
