

How to change front anti roll bar links on **CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9) 1.6 HDi 90 16V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – CITROËN BERLINGO II VAN (B9). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Ceramic grease
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench

- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket #17
- HEX No.H6 bit socket
- Wheel impact socket #19
- Ratchet wrench
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: anti roll bar links – CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Replace the stabiliser links on CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9) in pairs.
- The replacement procedure is identical for both stabiliser links on the same axle.
- Please note: all work on the car CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Raise the car.

AUTODOC recommends:

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.

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4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9)
- Remove the wheel.

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Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



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Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a combination spanner #17. Use HEX No.H6. Use a ratchet wrench.



9 Remove the stabiliser link.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9). Professionals recommend:

- Examine stabiliser bushes. Replace them if needed.
- Clean the mounting seats of the stabiliser link. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Treat the thread of the sway bar link fasteners. Use copper grease.



Install a new stabiliser link and tighten the fasteners. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



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Treat all joints of the stabiliser link. Use copper grease.



- Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.
- Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use ceramic grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: anti roll bar links – CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. CITROËN Berlingo II Van (B9)

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.



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Remove the jacks and chocks.







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
