
How to change engine oil and filter on **Honda Civic**8 – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – HONDA CIVIC 8. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # 10
- Drive socket # 17
- Oil filter cup socket 65-14F

- Ratchet wrench
- Funnel
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Oil drain pan
- Fender cover

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- · Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – HONDA CIVIC 8. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

1

Open the bonnet.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Unscrew the oil filler plug.



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4 Pull up the oil dipstick.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

AUTODOC recommends:

- The vehicle must be on a level surface, but if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.
- Support the engine splash guard. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



7 Unscrew the engine splash guard fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. AUTODOC recommends:

• Hold the engine splash guard firmly when unscrewing the fasteners and lowering the hydraulic transmission jack to avoid injury.





9 Remove the engine splash guard.

Support the oil pan guard. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Unscrew the oil pan guard fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



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AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid injury, hold the oil pan guard firmly when unscrewing the fasteners and lowering the hydraulic transmission jack.
- Lower the hydraulic transmission jack together with the oil pan guard.
- Remove the oil pan guard.

Put a waste oil container with at least 4 l capacity under the drainage hole.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



17 Drain the used oil.

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. Tip:

- Caution! The oil may be hot.
- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

Clean the oil filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Unscrew the oil filter. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a ratchet wrench.




Remove the oil filter.



Clean the oil filter seat. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.
- 23 Install a new oil filter.



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Tighten the oil filter. Remember to observe the recommended tightening torque. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 18 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Clean the drain plug and put a new 0-ring on it.



Reinstall the engine oil drain plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



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Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- Reinstall the oil pan guard.
- Support the oil pan guard. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Screw in the oil pan guard fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the hydraulic transmission jack.



33 Install the engine splash guard.

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Support the engine splash guard. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Tighten the engine splash guard fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Remove the hydraulic transmission jack.
- Lower the car.
- Remove the oil filler cap.



39 Insert the funnel.



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Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 3,7 l.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. Professionals recommend:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

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Check the oil level using the dipstick.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Top up oil if necessary.
- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

Install the oil filler cap.



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Tighten the oil filler cap.

Run the engine for a few minutes. After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.

Check the oil level with a dipstick 5 minutes after turning the engine off and add oil if necessary.



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Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- 49 Close the bonnet.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Honda Civic 8. Tip from AUTODOC:

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




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
