


How to change glass for wing mirror on **Opel Corsa D** – replacement guide

REPLACEMENT: GLASS FOR WING MIRROR – OPEL CORSA D. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Electronic spray
- Painter's tape

- Plastic trim tool
- Fender cover

Replacement: glass for wing mirror – Opel Corsa D. AUTODOC recommends:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left side mirror glass.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: GLASS FOR WING MIRROR – OPEL CORSA D. TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Use the masking tape to prevent plastic and painted parts of the car from being damaged.



Tilt the mirror glass out of the housing.

Carefully release the mirror glass from its attachment. Use a plastic trim tool.



Remove the mirror glass.



Replacement: glass for wing mirror – Opel Corsa D. Tip:

- Do not apply excessive force when removing the part. Otherwise you may damage it.
- Detach the mirror heating connectors.



Treat the mirror heating connectors. Use dielectric grease.

8 Attach the mirror heating connectors.



Install the new mirror glass. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: glass for wing mirror Opel Corsa D. To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.
- Make sure the mirror glass is positioned correctly. It should be aligned with the locking tabs on the housing.

Remove the masking tape.

11 Clean the mirror glass.



Remove the fender protection cover.



- Switch on the ignition. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Switch off the ignition.
