## SIMILAR VIDEO TUTORIAL



This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

### Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

DACIA LOGAN MCV II 1.6

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: NISSAN MICRA III (K12) 1.4 16V

**REPLACEMENT: BRAKE DISCS – DACIA LOGAN MCV II.  
TOOLS YOU NEED:**



- Wire brush
- Nylon cleaning brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Ceramic grease
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #13
- Combination spanner #15
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 17
- Torx bit T40
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Tap wrench
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Phillips screwdriver
- Crow bar
- Impact screwdriver
- Hammer
- Wheel chock

**Buy tools**

Replacement: brake discs – DACIA LOGAN MCV II. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the brake disks on the car DACIA LOGAN MCV II in pairs on an axle, regardless of the condition of the components. This will ensure even braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for both brake disks on the same axle.
- When changing the brake discs, always replace the brake pads.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

**REPLACEMENT: BRAKE DISCS – DACIA LOGAN MCV II.  
RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:**

**1** Open the bonnet.

**2** Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



**3** Secure the wheels with chocks.

4

Loosen the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a tap wrench.



5

Raise the car.

**AUTODOC recommends:**

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.

**7** Remove the wheel.



**8** Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



**9** Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



**10** Unscrew the brake caliper fasteners. Use a combination spanner #13. Use a combination spanner #15.



**11** Remove the fastening bolts.

**12**

Remove the brake caliper.

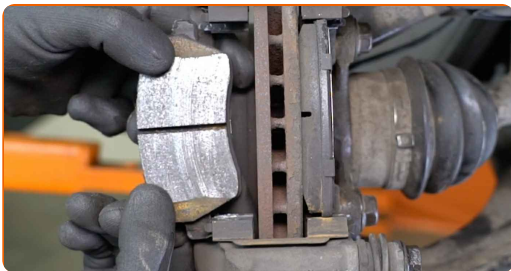


**Replacement: brake discs – DACIA LOGAN MCV II. Tip:**

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.

**13**

Remove the brake pads.



**14**

Clean the brake caliper bracket fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



**15**

Unscrew the brake caliper bracket fasteners. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



**16**

Remove the fastening bolts.

**17**

Remove the brake caliper bracket.



**18**

Clean the brake disc fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

**19**

Unscrew the brake disc fasteners. Use a Phillips screwdriver. Use an impact screwdriver. Use a hammer.





20 Remove the fastening bolts.

21 Remove the brake disc.



22 Clean the wheel hub. Use a wire brush.



23 Treat the contacting surface. Use ceramic grease.

24 Install a new brake disc.



25 Install the fastening bolts.



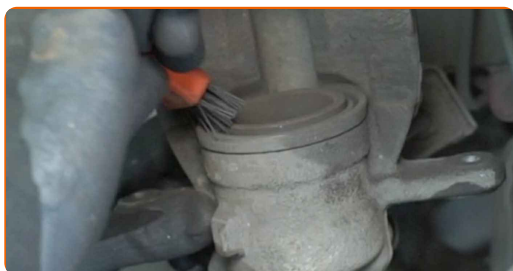

Tighten the brake disc fasteners. Use Torx T40. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 10 Nm torque.



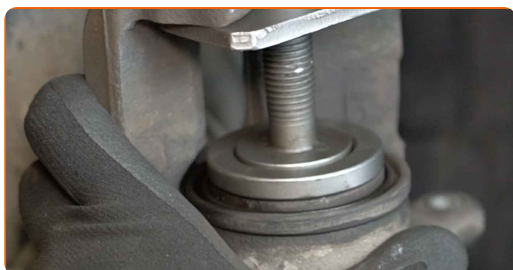

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a nylon cleaning brush. Use a brake cleaner.



28

Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



29

Clean the brake caliper bracket of dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake discs – DACIA LOGAN MCV II. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

Install the brake caliper bracket.



31

Install the fastening bolts.



32

Tighten the brake caliper bracket fasteners. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 105 Nm torque.



- 33** Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use anti-squeal paste.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

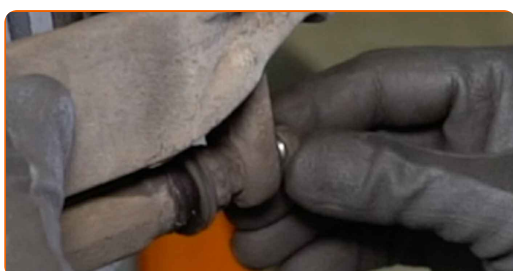
- 34** Install the brake pads.



- 35** Install the brake caliper and fasten it.



- 36** Install the fastening bolts.



- 37 Tighten the brake caliper fasteners. Use a combination spanner #15. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



- 38 Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use ceramic grease.



- 39 Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.

- 40 Install the wheel.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. DACIA LOGAN MCV II

41

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



42

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



43

Remove the jacks and chocks.



Replacement: brake discs – DACIA LOGAN MCV II. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until you feel significant resistance.
- Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and top up if necessary.

Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



45

Close the bonnet.
