
# (i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: FORD Fiesta Mk4 Hatchback (JAS, JBS) 1.6

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: FORD Fiesta Mk5 Hatchback (JH1, JD1, JH3, JD3) 1.4 16V





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Replacement: serpentine belt – FORD Fiesta Mk4 Hatchback (JAS, JBS). Professionals recommend:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# **REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – FORD FIESTA MK4 HATCHBACK (JAS, JBS). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:**

1 2 3

Open the bonnet.

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

Undo the fasteners of the oil pan lower cover. Use Torx T27.



5

Remove the oil pan cover.







Pry up the hydraulic power steering belt. Use a crowbar.

Turn the crankshaft pulley. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.



8

Remove the hydraulic power steering belt.



9

Pry up the poly-V belt. Use a crowbar.



10

Turn the crankshaft pulley. Use a crowbar. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.







Remove the V-ribbed belt.

Install the V-ribbed belt. Use a crowbar. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.



#### Replacement: serpentine belt – FORD Fiesta Mk4 Hatchback (JAS, JBS). Tip:

• Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.

Turn the crankshaft pulley. Use a crowbar. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.



Replacement: serpentine belt – FORD Fiesta Mk4 Hatchback (JAS, JBS). AUTODOC recommends:

• Proceed with caution! Don't damage the poly-V belt.

Reinstall the oil pan lower cover.

Tighten the fasteners of the oil pan lower cover. Use Torx T27.





Lower the car.

Remove the fender protection cover.





Close the hood.




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
