### REPLACEMENT: WING MIRROR – FORD FOCUS II ESTATE (DA\_, FFS, DS). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # 10
- Torx bit T25

- Ratchet wrench
- Plastic trim tool
- Fender cover

Replacement: wing mirror – FORD Focus II Estate (DA\_, FFS, DS). AUTODOC recommends:


• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# REPLACEMENT: WING MIRROR – FORD FOCUS II ESTATE (DA\_, FFS, DS). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the car door.
- Lower the window glass.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



4. Remove the wing mirror cover. Use a plastic trim tool.

5 Unscrew the fasteners of the wing mirror trim panel. Use Torx T25.



Detach the side mirror trim panel. Use a plastic trim tool.



Detach the speaker connector.

Detach the mirror adjuster connector from the door.

Remove the wing mirror screws. Use Torx T25. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



10 Remove the wing mirror.



11 Install the new wing mirror.

Tighten the screws of the wing mirror. Use Torx T25. Use a drive socket #10. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 5 Nm torque.



Attach the mirror adjuster connector to the door.

14 Attach the speaker connector.



Attach the side mirror trim panel.



Screw in the fasteners of the wing mirror trim panel. Use Torx T25.



17 Install the wing mirror housing.

Remove the fender protection cover.

Switch on the ignition. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.



- Switch off the ignition.
- Close the car door.




