## SIMILAR VIDEO TUTORIAL



This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

### ⓘ Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.4, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.6, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.4 TDCi, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.6 TDCi, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.25, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.3, FORD FUSION (JU\_) 1.4 LPG

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: FORD Fiesta Mk5 Hatchback (JH1, JD1, JH3, JD3) 1.4 16V

## REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – FORD FUSION (JU\_). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- HEX bit No.H7.
- Wheel impact socket #19
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work – FORD FUSION (JU\_).

## CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1 Open the hood. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



2 Secure the wheels with chocks.



3 Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.




**4**

Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

**5**

Unscrew the wheel bolts.




Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

**6**

Remove the wheel.

**7**

Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



**8**


Remove the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins. Use a crowbar.

**9**

Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use HEX No.H7. Use a ratchet wrench.

**10**

Detach the brake caliper retaining spring. Use a crowbar.

**11**

Remove the brake caliper.



## Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Tip:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

Remove the brake pads.



## Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

13

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

14

Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



15

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

- After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

16

Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use anti-squeal paste.



Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

17

Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:


- Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

**18**

Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use HEX No.H7. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.

**19**

Install the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins.

**20**

Install the brake caliper retaining spring.

**21**

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.

**22**

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



## AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

23

Install the wheel.



Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

24

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



25

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 95 Nm torque.



## AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.

Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



## AUTODOC recommends:


- FORD FUSION (JU\_) – Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until it feels firm.

27

Close the hood.

28

Remove the jacks and chocks.



Replacement: brake pads – FORD FUSION (JU\_). Professionals recommend:

- Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement.  
Avoid unnecessary and sharp braking to a stop.
