

This replacement procedure can be used for: FORD Grand C-Max (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU) 1.6 Ti

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: FORD Focus II Saloon (DB_, FCH, DH) 1.6 TDCi







Replacement: engine mounts – FORD Grand C-Max (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU). Tip:

All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE MOUNTS – FORD GRAND C-MAX (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

1Open the bonnet.2Use a fender prot

3

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Remove the engine cover.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: engine mounts – FORD Grand C-Max (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.



Support the engine in the oil pan area. Use a jack.

Clean the engine mount fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the upper fastener of the engine mount. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



7

Clean the engine mount fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



8

Unscrew the fasteners that connect the engine mount to the car body. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



9

Remove the hydraulic transmission jack.



10

Unscrew the engine mount fasteners. Use a drive socket #E11. Use a ratchet wrench.



11

Remove the engine mount.



Replacement: engine mounts – FORD Grand C-Max (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Carefully check the other engine mounts and replace them if necessary.

Clean the mounting seat of the engine mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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13

Install the engine mount to its mounting seat.



14

Tighten the engine mount fastening bolts. Use a drive socket #E11. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 32 Nm torque.



15

Tighten the fasteners that connect the engine mount to the car body. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 65 Nm torque.



16

Treat the engine mount fasteners. Use copper grease.





17

Tighten the upper fastener of the engine mount. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 55 Nm torque.



18

Treat the engine mount fasteners. Use copper grease.



19

Install the engine cover and secure it.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: engine mounts FORD Grand C-Max (DXA/CB7, DXA/CEU). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.
- Make sure the engine cover is properly seated. It should not be displaced with respect to the guiding fasteners.

Remove the fender protection cover.



Close the hood.




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
