This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 1.8 16V, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 2.0 16V, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 2.5 V6 24V, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 2.0 16V DI / TDDi / TDCi, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 2.0 TDCi, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) ST220, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 1.8 SCi, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 2.2 TDCi, FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y) 3.0 V6 24V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – FORD MONDEO MK3 HATCHBACK (B5Y). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Drive socket # 7
- Ratchet wrench
- Phillips screwdriver

- Microfibre towel
- Fender cover

Replacement: air filter – FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y). AUTODOC recommends:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – FORD MONDEO MK3 HATCHBACK (B5Y). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Undo the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Loosen the fastening clamp connecting the air duct to the air filter housing. Use a drive socket #7. Use a ratchet wrench.

5 Detach the air duct housing from the air filter housing.



Take off the filter lid.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: air filter FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.
- Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.

Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



Clean the air filter cover and housing.



Replacement: air filter – FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Before cleaning the air filter cover and housing, cover the air duct parts, mass airflow sensor (if available), throttle valve with a clean cloth.

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.

AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: air filter FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y). Be sure to position the filtering element correctly. Avoid misalignment.
- Take care to only use quality filters.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.
- Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.

AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: air filter FORD Mondeo Mk3 Hatchback (B5Y). To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.
- Screw the fastening clamp connecting the air duct to the air filter housing. Use a drive socket #7. Use a ratchet wrench.



Screw in the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- 17 Close the hood.




