

How to change front anti roll bar links on **Opel Astra G F48** – replacement guide

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – OPEL ASTRA G F48. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 18

- Combination spanner #19
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Torque wrench
- Wheel chock

AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the stabiliser links on Opel Astra G F48 in pairs.
- The replacement procedure is identical for both stabiliser links on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – OPEL ASTRA G F48. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. Opel Astra G F48
- Remove the wheel.



6 Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the nut and remove the stabilizer rod from the shock strut. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a drive socket #18.

- Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the fasteners connecting the stabiliser link to the stabiliser bar. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a drive socket #18.



Remove the stabilizer rod.



11.1 Install a new rod, tighten the fasteners.



Use a combination spanner #19. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 65 Nm torque.

Treat all joints of the stabiliser link. Use copper grease.



Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.

AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. Opel Astra G F48
- Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque 16 wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks. 17
