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How to change rear brake pads on **HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF)** – replacement guide

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF) 1.9 i, HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF) 2.0 i LS, HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF) 2.2 i VTEC, HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF) 2.0 TDi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #12
- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 12

- Drive socket # 17
- Wheel impact socket #19
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Rubber mallet
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

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Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). AUTODOC recommends:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This
 provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:



Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



2

Secure the wheels with chocks.



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Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



- Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.
- Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF)
- Remove the wheel.



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Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Detach the parking brake cable from the bracket on the brake caliper. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench. Use a crowbar.



Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a combination spanner #12. Use a combination spanner #17.



10 Remove the brake caliper.



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Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). Professionals recommend:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them.
 Replace, if necessary.

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Remove the brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). AUTODOC experts recommend:

 Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). Tip:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

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14 Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.
- Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



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Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use a combination spanner #12. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #12. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 23 Nm torque.



Install the parking brake cable into the brake caliper bracket. Use a rubber mallet. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.

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AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.
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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 108 Nm torque.



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Remove the jacks and chocks.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Replacement: brake pads – HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF). Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.

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Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

• HONDA ACCORD V (CE, CF) – Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until it feels firm.

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Close the hood.

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• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.



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
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
