This replacement procedure can be used for: HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_) 1.3 HYBRID (GP1)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: HONDA INSIGHT (ZE_) 1.3 Hybrid (ZE2)

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REPLACEMENT: SPARK PLUGS – HONDA JAZZ III HATCHBACK (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- High-temperature anti-seize lubricant
- Drive socket # 10
- Spark plug socket # 16
- Ratchet wrench

- Torque wrench
- Telescoping magnet
- Flat Screwdriver
- Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: spark plugs – HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- The replacement procedure is the same for all spark plugs.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_).

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the engine cover.



Unplug the connectors from the ignition coils.



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5 Unscrew the fasteners of the ignition coils. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Take out the ignition coils from the spark plug wells.



Replacement: spark plugs – HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_). AUTODOC recommends:

- Remember the sequence of steps for ignition coil demounting.
- Clean dirt, dust and debris from inside the spark plug wells.



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Unscrew the spark plugs. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



Take out the spark plugs. Use a telescoping magnet.



- Apply a thin layer of a special high temperature anti-seize lubricant to the threads of the new spark plugs. Use a flat screwdriver.
- Install the new spark plugs into their mounting seats. Use the spark plug socket #16.



Screw new spark plugs and tighten them. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 nm torque.



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Replacement: spark plugs – HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_). Professionals recommend:

- Don't tighten the plugs with excessive force. Exceeding tightening torque can damage the thread connection.
- Be careful when working with a spark plug wrench. Its skewing can cause damage to the threaded connection.





AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: spark plugs HONDA Jazz III Hatchback (GE_, GG_, GP_, ZA_).
 Follow the installation steps.
- Tighten the ignition coil fastening. Use a drive socket #10. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 8 nm torque.



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Plug in the connectors of the ignition coils.



- 16 Install the engine cover.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.
- 19 Remove the fender protection cover.
- 20 Close the hood.



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
