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How to change rear brake pads on **HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1) 2.5 TCi, HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1) 2.4

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: HYUNDAI SANTA FÉ II (CM) 2.2 CRDi

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REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – HYUNDAI H-1 / STAREX MPV (A1). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- Nylon cleaning brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench

- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 14
- Wheel impact socket #21
- Ratchet wrench
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- Please note: all work on the car HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the hood. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.
- Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

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5 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
 HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1)
- Remove the wheel.



- Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the guide pins from the old brake caliper.

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- Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.
- Remove the brake caliper. Use a crowbar.



Replacement: brake pads - HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

Remove the brake pads.



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Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.
- Remove the brake pads retaining clips.
- Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



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Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.
- 16 Install the brake pads retaining clips.
- 17 Install new brake pads.

Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip:

- Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.
- Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a nylon cleaning brush. Use a brake cleaner.



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AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.





20 Install the brake caliper and fix it.



- Screw in the guide pins.
- Tighten the brake caliper fasteners. Use a drive socket #14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



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Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

25 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1)

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 108 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and refill if necessary.
- Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until you feel significant resistance.

Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap. Close the hood.

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Replacement: brake pads – HYUNDAI H-1 / Starex MPV (A1). Tip:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.



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
