
How to change rear shock absorbers on Renault Kangoo KC01 – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) 1.5 dCi, RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) 1.2, RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) 1.4, RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) D 55 1.9 (KC0D), RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) D 65 1.9 (KC0E, KC02, KC0J, KC0N), RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) 1.2, RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) 1.4, RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) D 55 1.9 (FC0D), RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) D 65 1.9 (FC0E, FC02, FC0J, FC0N), RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) 1.9 dTi, RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) 1.9 dTi, RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) 1.6 16V, RENAULT KANGOO (KC0/1_) 1.5 dCi, RENAULT KANGOO Express (FC0/1_) 1.6 16V, (+ 12)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – RENAULT KANGOO KC01. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 16
- Combination spanner #18

- Wheel impact socket #19
- Tap wrench
- Torque wrench
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Replacement: shock absorbers – Renault Kangoo KC01. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Both shock absorbers of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right shock absorbers of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – RENAULT KANGOO KC01. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



3

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: shock absorbers – Renault Kangoo KC01. AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.
- Remove the wheel.



6 Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.



Unscrew the upper fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #16. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a tap wrench.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Renault Kangoo KC01 – To avoid injury, hold the shock absorber while unscrewing the fastening bolts.

10 Remove the shock absorber.



Replacement: shock absorbers – Renault Kangoo KC01. Tip:

• Before installing a new shock absorber you should pump it manually 3-5 times.

Place the shock absorber in the wheel arch and fasten it.



Tighten the top shock absorber fastening. Use a drive socket #16. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 105 Nm torque.



Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 105 Nm torque.



Remove the support from under the rear arm.

Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.



16 Install the wheel.



Replacement: shock absorbers – Renault Kangoo KC01. Tip from AUTODOC:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



19 Remove the jacks and chocks.






