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How to change rear shock absorbers on **Toyota Prado J120** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 4.0, TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 3.0 D, TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 3.0 D-4D, TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 3.4, TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 4.0 (GRJ12), TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 2.7, TOYOTA LAND CRUISER (KDJ12\_, GRJ12\_) 4.0 V6 VVT-i (GRJ125)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



#### REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – TOYOTA PRADO J120. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Multipurpose grease
- Combination spanner #12
- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 17

- Wheel impact socket #21
- Torque wrench
- Tap wrench
- Locking pliers
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

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- Both shock absorbers of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right shock absorbers of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## **REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – TOYOTA PRADO J120. TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:**



- Secure the wheels with chocks.

- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.





Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.







Unscrew the wheel bolts.



#### Replacement: shock absorbers – Toyota Prado J120. AUTODOC recommends:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.



Remove the wheel.



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Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.





Unscrew the upper fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #17. Use locking pliers.

Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #17. Use a tap wrench.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• To avoid injuries, hold the shock absorber when undoing the fastening bolts.



Remove the fastening bolt.



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Remove the shock absorber. Use a crowbar.







Treat the shock absorber mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



## Replacement: shock absorbers – Toyota Prado J120. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Before installing a new shock absorber you should pump it manually 3-5 times.



Treat the shock absorber fasteners. Use a multipurpose grease.



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Place the shock absorber in the wheel arch and secure it.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

 Important! Hold the shock absorber while screwing in the fastening bolts. Toyota Prado J120



Install the fastening bolt.



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Screw in the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #17.

Screw the upper fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #17.

Tighten the top shock absorber fastening. Use a combination spanner #12. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



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Treat the shock absorber fasteners. Use copper grease.





Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 98 Nm torque.



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Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: shock absorbers – Toyota Prado J120. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.







Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: shock absorbers – Toyota Prado J120. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



Replacement: shock absorbers – Toyota Prado J120. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.





Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 112 nm torque.



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Remove the jacks and chocks.





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
