The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



## REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – SEAT LEON 1P1. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Phillips screwdriver
- Microfibre towel

### Replacement: air filter – Seat Leon 1P1. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Please note: all work on the car Seat Leon 1P1 should be done with the engine switched off.

## **CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:**

1 Open the bonnet.



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



Undo the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.

4 Take off the filter lid.



Unscrew the filter element fastener. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



Clean the air filter cover and housing.

9 Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.



Insert a new filter element into the filter housing.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Attention! Use quality filters Seat Leon 1P1.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.

Screw in the filter element fastener. Use a Phillips screwdriver.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.



### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Caution! Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the fasteners of the car. Seat Leon 1P1
- Screw in the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



Remove the fender protection cover.


