

How to change tailgate struts on **Seat Leon 1P1** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 1.6, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 2.0 TFSI, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 1.9 TDI, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 2.0 TDI 16V, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 2.0 TDI, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 1.4 TSI, SEAT Leon II Hatchback (1P1) 1.8 TSI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS – SEAT LEON 1P1. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- WD-40 spray
- Flat Screwdriver

• Hydraulic transmission jack

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Replacement: tailgate struts – Seat Leon 1P1. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Right and left gas struts of the boot lid should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left gas struts of the boot lid.
- Please note: all work on the car Seat Leon 1P1 should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1 Oper

Open the boot lid.

Support the boot lid. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid. Use a flat screwdriver.
