

How to change engine oil and filter on **Renault Master 2 van** – replacement guide

# important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

RENAULT Vel Satis Hatchback 2.2 dCi (BJ0M), RENAULT ESPACE III (JE0\_) 2.2 dCi (JE0K), RENAULT MASTER II Bus (JD) 2.2 dCl 90, RENAULT MASTER II Box (FD) 2.2 dCl 90, RENAULT MASTER II Platform/Chassis (ED/HD/UD) 2.2 dCl 90, RENAULT LAGUNA II (BG0/1\_) 2.2 dCi, RENAULT LAGUNA II Grandtour (KG0/1\_) 2.2 dCi, RENAULT Vel Satis Hatchback 2.2 dCi, RENAULT MASTER II Bus (JD) 2.5 dCi 120, RENAULT MASTER II Box (FD) 2.5 dCi 120, RENAULT MASTER II Platform/Chassis (ED/HD/UD) 2.5 dCi 120, RENAULT ESPACE IV (JK0/1\_) 2.2 dCi, RENAULT TRAFIC II Box (FL) 2.5 dCi 135 (FL0D), RENAULT Avantime Van 2.2 dCi, RENAULT TRAFIC II Bus (JL) 2.5 dCi 135 (JL0D), (+ 5)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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# REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER - RENAULT MASTER 2 VAN. TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torque wrench
- 8 mm square head drain plug socket
- 96-18F cup type oil filter wrench
- Ratchet screwdriver or power tool for removal/installation of threaded fasteners
- Slotted screwdriver
- Funnel
- Oil drain pan
- Fender cover

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# Replacement: engine oil and filter – Renault Master 2 van. AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the oil filter every time you change the engine oil.
- Before getting down to work, warm up the engine to reduce the viscosity of the oil.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work Renault Master 2 van.

## **CARRY OUT THE REPLACEMENT STEPS AS FOLLOWS:**

1

Open the bonnet.



2

Use a fender protection cover to avoid damaging the paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



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3 Unscrew the oil filler cap.



Pull up the oil dipstick.



Lift the vehicle using a vehicle lift or place it over an inspection pit.



# Replacement: engine oil and filter – Renault Master 2 van. Tip:

• The vehicle must be level, but if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.

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Put an oil drain pan with a capacity of at least 8 litres under the drain hole.



Clean the area of the oil pan drain hole. Use a wire brush. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.



Unscrew the drain plug. Use an 8 mm square head drain plug socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



9 Drain the used oil.



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### Caution!

- The oil may be hot.
- Wait until the oil has completely flowed out of the drain hole.
- Clean the oil filter cap. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.



Unscrew the filter cap together with the old filter element. Use a 96-18F oil filter cup wrench. Use a ratchet wrench.



### Caution!

- The oil may be hot.
- Remove the filter element from the filter cap. Remove the old O-ring of the oil filter cap. Use a slotted screwdriver.



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Clean the oil filter cap. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.



Remove the O-ring from the drain plug. Use a slotted screwdriver.



Clean the drain plug. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.



16 Install a new O-ring on the oil filter cap.



17 Install a new filter element into the oil filter cap.



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Lubricate the new O-ring of the oil filter cap with a small amount of fresh oil.



19 Install a new O-ring on the drain plug.

Clean the oil filter mounting seat. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.



Install the oil filter cap and screw it in. Use a 96-18F oil filter cup wrench. Use a torque wrench. Tightening torque: 25 N·m.



Clean the area of the oil pan drain hole. Use an all-purpose cleaning spray.

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Screw in the drain plug and tighten it. Use an 8 mm square head drain plug socket. Use a torque wrench. Tightening torque: 25 N·m.



- Lower the vehicle.
- Remove the oil filler cap.



26 Insert the funnel.



Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 8 L.



# Important!

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

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Check the oil level using the dipstick.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Renault Master 2 van. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Top up oil if necessary.

Remove the funnel and screw in the oil filler cap.



Run the engine for a few minutes.

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### Warning!

- The oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the passages, and the light will go out.
- Check the oil level with a dipstick in 5 minutes after turning the engine off and add oil if necessary.



# Replacement: engine oil and filter – Renault Master 2 van. Professionals recommend:

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drain hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, tighten them up carefully.
- Remove the fender cover.



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Close the bonnet. 35



### AUTODOC recommendation:

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters and oil at special collection points.






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
