How to change rear brake pads on MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) – replacement guide

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 200 D (202.120), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 220 D (202.121), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 250 D (202.125), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 180 (202.018), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 220 (202.022), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 280 (202.028), MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) C 200 (202.020)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – MERCEDES-BENZ C-CLASS SALOON (W202). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Ceramic grease
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 17
- HEX bit No.H5

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Flat Screwdriver
- Pin punch
- Hammer
- Tap wrench
- Long nose pliers
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202). AUTODOC recommends:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This
 provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – MERCEDES-BENZ C-CLASS SALOON (W202). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

- Open the bonnet.
- Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a tap wrench.



Raise the car.

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AUTODOC recommends:

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202). Tip:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

Remove the wheel.



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Clean the brake pad guide pins. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Remove the brake pad guide pins. Use a pin punch. Use a hammer.



Remove the retaining spring of the brake pads.



Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar (2 pieces).



12 Remove the brake pads.



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AUTODOC recommends:

 Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

Clean the mounting seats of the brake pads on the brake caliper bracket. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.

AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install new brake shoes.

Install the retaining spring of the brake pads.



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Install the brake pad guide pins. Use a pin punch. Use a hammer.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use ceramic grease.



19 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202)

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



AUTODOC recommends:

- MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202) Press the brake pedal several times with the engine shut down until you feel the resistance built up.
- Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and top up if necessary.

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Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



Close the bonnet.

Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ C-Class Saloon (W202). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.




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
