## i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 250 CGI (207.347), MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 220 CDI / d (207.302, 207.301), MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 200 CGI (207.348), MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 200 (207.334), MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 220 BlueTEC (207.301), MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) E 220 CDI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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### REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – MERCEDES-BENZ E-CLASS COUPE (C207). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- Nylon cleaning brush
- WD-40 spray
- Electronic spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Ceramic grease
- Torque wrench

- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket #13
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Long nose pliers
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

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## Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- Please note: all work on the car MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207) should be done with the engine switched off.

### **CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:**

- Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.
- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Raise the car.

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## Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). Tip from AUTODOC:

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.

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Unscrew the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207)

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Remove the wheel.



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Detach the connector of the brake pad wear sensor. Use long nose pliers.



Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



- Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the brake caliper fasteners. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.



11 Remove the fastening bolts.



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Remove the brake caliper.



## Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.

13 Remove the brake pads.



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#### Replacement: brake pads – MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). Tip:

 Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

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Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

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Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



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






#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.



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Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a nylon cleaning brush. Use a brake cleaner.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



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19 Install the brake caliper and fix it.



20 Install the fastening bolts.



Tighten the brake caliper fasteners. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 34 Nm torque.



Treat the brake pad wear sensor plug. Use dielectric grease.



Attach the connector of the brake pad wear sensor.

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Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use ceramic grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

27 Install the wheel.



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#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

 Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207)

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 130 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



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#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until you feel significant resistance.
- Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and refill if necessary.

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Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap. Close the hood.



Replacement: brake pads - MERCEDES-BENZ E-Class Coupe (C207). Tip from **AUTODOC:** 

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.





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
