

This replacement procedure can be used for:

MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 350 CDI 4-matic (251.023, 251.123), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 320 CDI 4-matic (251.022, 251.122), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 280 CDI 4-matic (251.020), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 280 CDI (251.121, 251.026, 251.126), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 300 CDI (251.021, 251.121, 251.026, 251.126), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 300 CDI 4-matic (251.020), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 350 CDI 4-matic (251.022, 251.122), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 350 CDI 4-matic (251.022, 251.125), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 350 CDI 4-matic (251.124, 251.125), MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) R 320 CDI 4-matic (251.125)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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Open the hood.





• Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.

 Please note: all work on the car – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) – should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Unscrew the engine cover fastener. Use Torx T25. Use a ratchet wrench.



Unscrew the fasteners of the back section of the engine cover. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.





Remove the back section of the engine cover.







 Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.

Remove the engine cover.

AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). To avoid damaging the part when removing it, do not use excessive force.

Clean the fuel filter housing and the cover. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

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Loosen the fuel filter mounting. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.





Loosen the fastening clamps of the fuel filter pipes. Use a drive socket #5.5. Use a drive socket #7. Use a ratchet wrench.

Detach the tubes from the fuel filter. Use round-nose pliers.



Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). Tip:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.



Remove the fuel filter.







Install a new fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Make sure that the fuel filter is positioned correctly. Consider the fuel flow direction mark.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251) It's important to only use high-quality filters.

Clean the fuel filter housing and the cover. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Attach the pipe to the fuel filter.





Tighten the fastening clamp of the fuel filter pipe. Use a drive socket #5.5. Use a ratchet wrench.

Press the fuel primer pump several times until it gets hard. Use a bulb hand fuel pump.



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Attach the pipe to the fuel filter.



18

Tighten the fastening clamp of the fuel filter pipe. Use a drive socket #7. Use a ratchet wrench.





Clean the fuel filter housing and the cover. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



20

Screw in the fuel filter mounting bracket. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



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Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.



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Shut off the engine.

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Install the engine cover and secure it.

AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.



Screw in the engine cover fasteners. Use Torx T25. Use a ratchet wrench.

Put the back section of the engine cover back in place.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: fuel filter – MERCEDES-BENZ R-Class (W251, V251). To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.

Screw in the fasteners of the back section of the engine cover. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the fender protection cover.
