

How to change tailgate struts on MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 230 TD (638.274), MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 230 (638.234, 638.294), MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 280 (638.244, 638.294), MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 200 (638.214, 638.294), MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 200 CDI (638.294), MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2) V 220 CDI (638.294)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS – MERCEDES-BENZ V-CLASS (W638/2). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



• Flat Screwdriver

• Hydraulic transmission jack

Buy tools

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Replacement: tailgate struts – MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Right and left gas struts of the boot lid should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left gas struts of the boot lid.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS – MERCEDES-BENZ V-CLASS (W638/2). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

Open the boot lid.

Support the boot lid. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the car body. Use a flat screwdriver.



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Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid. Use a flat screwdriver.



AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid any injuries, be sure to hold the boot lid while demounting the gas struts.
- Remove the boot lid gas strut.



Install the new boot lid gas strut.



Replacement: tailgate struts – MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2). Professionals recommend:

• To avoid any injuries, be sure to hold the boot lid while installing the gas strut.

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Snap on the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid.



Snap on the circlip connecting the gas strut to the car body. Use a flat screwdriver.



Remove the hydraulic transmission jack.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: tailgate struts – MERCEDES-BENZ V-Class (W638/2). Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

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Check the working condition of the boot lid gas springs after they are installed.



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Close the lid of the luggage compartment.




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
