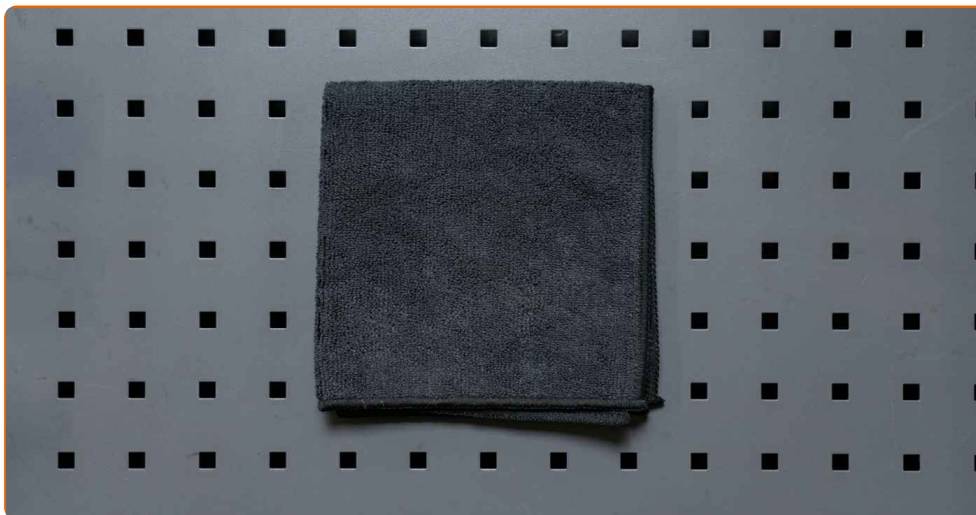
This replacement procedure can be used for:

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – MERCEDES-BENZ W124
ESTATE (S124). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



• Microfibre towel

• Fender cover

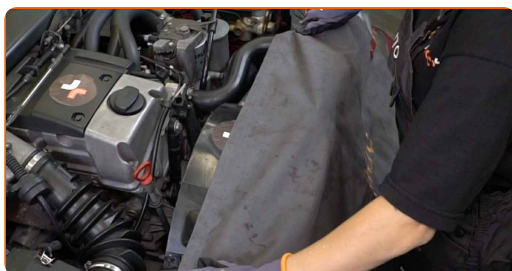
Replacement: air filter – MERCEDES-BENZ W124 Estate (S124). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1 Open the bonnet.

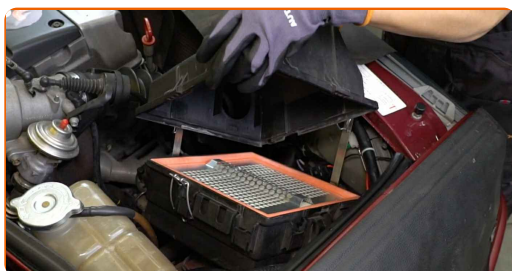
2 Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



3 Release the air filter cover clips.



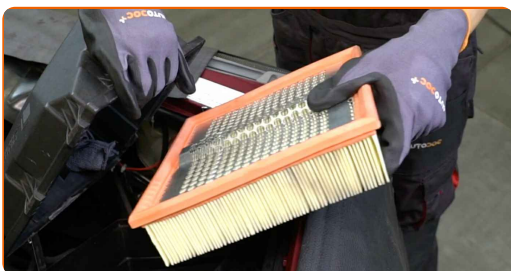
4 Remove the air filter cover.



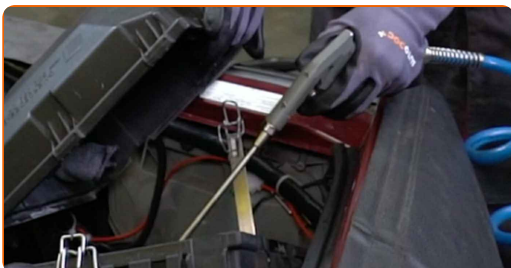
5 Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



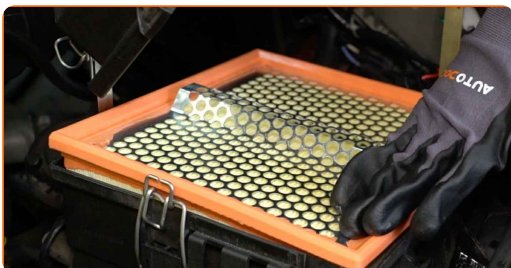
6 Remove the air filter.



7 Clean the air filter cover and housing.



8 Install the air filter.



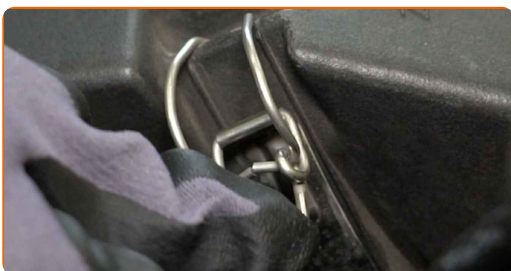
9 Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.



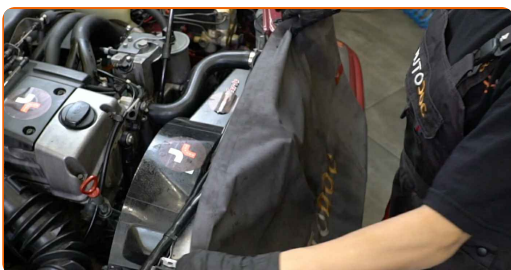
10 Install the air filter cover. Fasten it.



11 Press the air filter cover clips into place.



12 Remove the fender protection cover.



13 Close the bonnet.
