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How to change front strut mount on **Nissan Micra K11** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: NISSAN MICRA II (K11) 1.0 i 16V, NISSAN MICRA II (K11) 1.5 D, NISSAN MICRA II (K11) 1.4 i 16V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: STRUT MOUNT – NISSAN MICRA K11. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 12
- Drive socket # 17
- Combination spanner #14
- Combination spanner #17
- Wheel impact socket #19

- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Adjustable wrench
- Hydraulic strut spring compressor
- Pliers
- Rubber mallet
- Crow bar
- Fender cover
- Wheel chock

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: strut mount – Nissan Micra K11. Tip from AUTODOC:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the mounts of the left and right shock struts of the front suspension.
- All mounts of the front shock struts should be replaced simultaneously.
- Please note: all work on the car Nissan Micra K11 should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



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Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.



✓ Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
 Nissan Micra K11
- Remove the wheel.



Take out the retainer clip and move the brake hose out of the bracket on the shock strut. Use pliers.



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- Clean the fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the fasteners connecting the suspension strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Remove the fastening bolts (2 pieces).
- Disconnect the steering knuckle from the shock absorber strut. Use a crowbar.



11 Lower the car.



Open the bonnet.



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- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Clean the fasteners of the shock strut upper mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the upper fasteners of the shock strut (3 pieces). Use a drive socket #E12. Use a ratchet wrench.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the suspension strut while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
 Nissan Micra K11
- Remove the suspension strut.



Set the shock absorber strut on the spring compressor tool.



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Replacement: strut mount – Nissan Micra K11. Tip:

- Note that when using a spring compressor, spring coils need to be securely gripped, compressing the spring on the opposite sides.
- Ensure the correct position of the spring in the retainer.
- Make sure that the spring coils tightly entered the lock handles.

Compress the spring.



- Clean the upper fastener of the suspension strut mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the top fastening of the shock strut mount. Use a combination spanner #14. Use an adjustable wrench.



Remove the top strut mount.



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Replacement: strut mount – Nissan Micra K11. Professionals recommend:

 Examine the shock absorber dust cap and the bump stop. Replace them if necessary.

Install a new top shock strut mount.



Tighten the upper fastener of the shock absorber strut mount. Use a combination spanner #14. Use an adjustable wrench. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.



Replacement: strut mount – Nissan Micra K11. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Check to make sure the spring is positioned correctly. Avoid its misalignment.

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Treat the shock strut rod. Use copper grease.



- Decompress the spring.
- Remove the assembled shock strut.



Install the shock strut into the wheel arch.



Secure the upper fasteners of the shock strut (3 pieces).



AUTODOC recommends:

Important! Hold the suspension strut while screwing in the fastening bolts.
 Nissan Micra K11

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Tighten the upper fasteners of the shock strut (3 pieces). Use a drive socket #12. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.



Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.



- Treat the shock strut mounting seat on the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Fix the shock absorber strut on the steering knuckle.
- Install the fastening bolts (2 pieces).



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Tighten the lower fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 115 Nm torque.



Fasten the brake hose on the strut.

Attach the brake hose retainer clip. Use a rubber mallet.



Treat the shock strut fasteners. Use copper grease.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



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Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: strut mount – Nissan Micra K11. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



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Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.





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
