

#### PREPARE THE EQUIPMENT:



- New gas struts
- A WD-40 spray

- Clean rags or a thick cloth
- A flathead screwdriver








#### AUTODOC recommends:

• They have to be replaced as a pair





2 Vehicles may feature one or two gas struts



The gas strut is filled with high-pressure gas



The gas helps to lift and support the lid

These components usually stop working due to worn seals and gas leaks



The design of tailgate gas strut fittings is similar for most vehicles



The fitting includes a metal clip. Pry it up using a flathead screwdriver



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Before proceeding, find an assistant who can help by holding the boot lid open during the replacement
- Alternatively, you can use something to prop up the lid

8 While holding the lid with one hand, pry out the metal clip



Disconnect the gas strut from the ball attachment



Repeat the process with the bottom fitting



11 Remove the strut



Clean the fittings

#### Important!

- The inside of the new gas strut end fittings should be lubricated
- Install the new components in the exact position specified by the manufacturer

13 Install the new gas strut



Press the gas strut onto the ball attachment



Repeat the process with the second gas strut



Some struts include mounting brackets

These are secured with bolts



### Important!

- Handle the parts with care to avoid damaging the paintwork
- If the mounting components are not lined up with one another, rotate the upper fitting on the rod of the new strut



Check whether the gas struts are functioning properly
