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How to change front brake pads on NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 1.6 CVTC, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 2.0, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 2.0 All-wheel Drive, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 1.5 dCi, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 1.6 dCi, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E) 1.6 dCi All-wheel Drive

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – NISSAN QASHQAI / QASHQAI+2 I VAN (J10, JJ10E). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- Nylon cleaning brush
- WD-40 spray
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench

- Combination spanner #17
- Drive socket # 14
- Wheel impact socket #21
- Ratchet wrench
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This
 provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS - NISSAN QASHQAI / QASHQAI+2 I VAN (J10, JJ10E). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.
- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



A Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.



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5 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E)
- Remove the wheel.

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Spread the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the brake caliper.



Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E).

Professionals recommend:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them.
 Replace, if necessary.

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11 Remove the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.
- Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E). Tip:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

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14 Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E).

AUTODOC recommends:

• Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a nylon cleaning brush. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E).
 After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.



Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use a combination spanner #17. Use a drive socket #14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 34 Nm torque.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake pads – NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E). AUTODOC experts recommend:

After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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20 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E)
- Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 112 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



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AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Replacement: brake pads - NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I Van (J10, JJ10E). Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.

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Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until you feel significant resistance.

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Close the hood.

Replacement: brake pads - NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai + 2 I Van (J10, JJ10E). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.





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
