This replacement procedure can be used for: NISSAN TEANA I (J31) 2.0, NISSAN TEANA I (J31) 2.3, NISSAN TEANA I (J31) 3.5, NISSAN TEANA I (J31) 2.5 FOUR All-wheel Drive (TNJ31)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: NISSAN X-TRAIL (T30) $2.5\,4x4$



REPLACEMENT: POLLEN FILTER – NISSAN TEANA I (J31). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Torx bit T20
- Plastic trim tool

Pliers

Buy tools

Replacement: pollen filter – NISSAN TEANA I (J31). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- Please note: all work on the car NISSAN TEANA I (J31) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Open the glove box.

Remove the glove box stoppers. Use a plastic trim tool.

Remove the glove box.



Unscrew the fasteners on the rear panel of the glove box. Use Torx T20.



Detach the fasteners connecting the relay to the rear panel. Use pliers.



6 Remove the lower part of the rear panel.



Remove the rear panel of the glove box.

8 Unclip the cabin filter cover retainers.




Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



10 Remove the cabin filter.

Replacement: pollen filter – NISSAN TEANA I (J31). AUTODOC recommends:

- Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.
- Install a new cabin filter according to the air flow direction mark.

Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



Attach the fasteners connecting the relay to the rear panel.



14 Install the rear panel of the glove box.



15 Install the lower part of the rear panel.

Screw in the fasteners on the rear panel of the glove box. Use Torx T20.

18 Install the glove box stoppers.



Close the glove box.



- Switch on the ignition.
- Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- 22 Switch off the ignition.
